HORSE RULES

- 1. Entries must be into the secretary's office by June 1st, 2024.
- 2. There will be an additional charge of \$2.00 per entry and per change made to the entries after June 1st.
- 3. Valid negative Coggins test is required dated no later than 1 year from the last date of competition.
- 4. Owner and Exhibitors Certificate of Insurance (minimum \$1,000,000) must accompany entry forms.
- 5. There is one entry-form for every exhibitor.
- 6. All Sport Ponies must be registered in a qualifying association (halter and under saddle).
- 7. All horses offered for entry to Expo Ormstown must be free from, and not have come into contact with any contagious or infectious disease for a period of at least sixty (60) days prior to the opening of the exhibition. It is strongly recommended that animals have all the necessary vaccinations.
- 8. Each rider must have their own <u>exhibitor</u> number which is assigned at the time of registration. Exhibitor numbers and back numbers are not the same. Those who have shown at the fair in previous years already have an exhibitor number.
- 9. **Multiple Riders may not be registered under one exhibitor number.** We will gladly help exhibitors who have questions or are having difficulty making registrations.
- 10. There will be a capped entry fee amount of \$ 80.00 per exhibitor. The additional \$2.00 post entry fee will still apply. The Expo Assist program does not calculate this, so exhibitors over the \$80 will need to communicate with the committee to ensure you are credited the amount you are over.
- 11. The *NEW* Peewee division is for exhibitors with very little show experience. Exhibitors must be 10 years of age or younger and will be a walk only division, unassisted. Exhibitors in this division are not eligible for other divisions.
- 12. Back numbers are assigned to the rider/driver. Each exhibitor will have their own number. Exhibitors may use their own back numbers if no conflict with other exhibitors exists.
- 13. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to be wearing the proper back number. Prize money is awarded to the exhibitor. Wearing the wrong number may incur errors in prize money distribution. These errors are not the responsibility of the office and will not be corrected by the office.
- 14. Payment must accompany the entry form. No refunds will be given unless documentation from a veterinarian is provided.
- 15. Taxes are included in the entry fees and stall rentals.
- 16. On Wednesday and Thursday, the horses may arrive at anytime except during Parade time on Thursday approximately 6 to 8 pm.
- 17. From Friday to Sunday the horses must arrive on the grounds PRIOR to 9am
- Friday and Saturday nights the horses may depart from the fairgrounds between the hours of 11pm and 9 am. Sunday the Horses may leave at the end of the show.
- 19. Desjardins Expo Ormstown, including its directors, committee members and volunteers shall not be responsible in any way for any article or animal lost or stolen on the fairgrounds, nor shall it be responsible for any damage caused on the fairgrounds.
- 20. The use of stalls is mandatory **New** Stalls are mandatory and are offered free of charge however they **must be completely cleaned out prior to leaving.** If an exhibitor does not clean the stalls a 30\$ per stall charge will be deducted from winnings.
- 21. Stalls will be assigned based on the needs of all exhibitors; no guarantees of specific placement will be given to anyone. Tack stalls are not guaranteed. Stalls will be assigned after all horses have been

accommodated and in the same order as the requests were received at the office. Sharing among exhibitors is allowed.

- 22. All animals in the Halter classes and breed specific classes must be registered and a copy of the registration papers must accompany the entry form.
- 23. If you wish to scratch from a class, please advise the committee at the sound booth in the hitching ring as soon as possible.
- 24. The judge may excuse a competitor from the ring if they are deemed to be out of control, disruptive or a danger to themselves or others.
- 25. All decisions of the judge are final. Any complaints must be registered with the committee chairperson immediately following the class. The fee for such a complaint is \$50.00, which will be refunded if the protest is sustained.
- 26. ASTM approved helmets are mandatory for all exhibitors under 18 years of age while riding ANYWHERE on the fairgrounds.
- 27. Ponies are to be 14.2hh or under. Horses to be 14.2hh or over. An animal measuring 14.2hh may be shown either as a horse or a pony but must be shown exclusively in one division for the duration of the fair.
- 28. A Ribbon recycling program is now in place. Anyone wishing to return their ribbons may do so at the hitching ring.
- 29. All vehicles must be parked in the designated parking areas. No vehicles will be allowed to park around the barns without the proper passes and could result having the vehicle towed.
- 30. Desjardins Expo Ormstown and the Acting horse committee has a <u>Zero tolerance</u> stance towards abuse or misconduct of animals. If any person, exhibitor or otherwise is deemed in violation of said stance they will be excused from competition or asked to leave the grounds without warning.
- 31. ANY campers/trailer staying on the grounds with or without hookups must reserve a site This includes trailers with sleeping quarters.
- 32. *NEW NOTE* There will no longer be leniency at the exhibitor's entrance (gate 2) After 9am no one will be allowed admission to have items dropped off. No one will be allowed to enter gate 2 without a pass. If an exhibitor needs something dropped off, they can meet someone at the gate to collect the item needed.
- 33. By completing your entry form you are hereby accepting and acknowledging having read and obtained an understanding of these rules.
