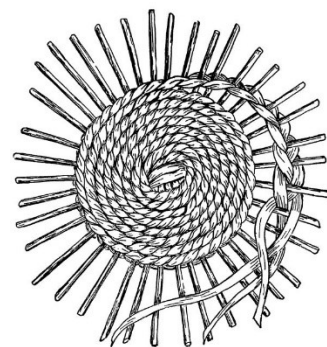
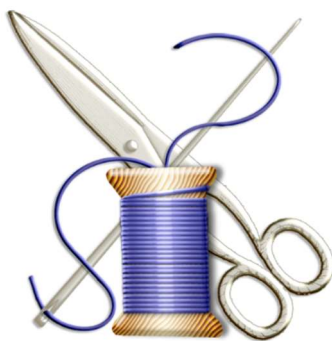
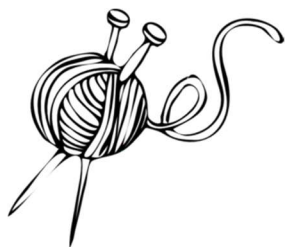
Entries close June 6th, and articles to be exhibited must be in place by Wednesday, June 10<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 p.m. Articles can also be brought in Tuesday night, June 9<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 – 8:00 p.m. **Plant & Flower articles must be in place before 12:00 noon, Thursday, June 11<sup>th</sup>.** Late arrivals may be displayed but are not eligible for judging. No refunds. Items exhibited must remain on display until the close of the Fair on Sunday, June 14<sup>th</sup>. All items are to be picked up **after** 4:00 p.m. No exhibits will be accepted after the above-mentioned hours. No Refunds. **No substitutions.**

- ✂ **Fees: \$2/entry (taxes included)** Note: Entry fees will double after June 6<sup>st</sup>. **NO MORE THAN THREE ENTRIES PER CLASS. Absolutely no entries accepted after 10am, Monday, June 8<sup>th</sup>.**
- ✂ An exhibitor may receive no more than two prizes in any one class.
- ✂ **10 articles** must be entered before a free week pass can be given to an exhibitor. One week pass each additional 10 entries. **Competitors are asked to pick up their tags prior to the fair and have them filled out and fastened securely**
- ✂ Passes will be given upon receipt of articles on Tuesday evening and Wednesday morning.  
\*Saturday show entries do not count towards free passes.
- ✂ Articles soiled, defaced by wear or previously shown are not eligible for competition
- ✂ Entries must be made in proper section and class in order to compete. Study prize list carefully ensure you have the right numbers on your entry forms.
- ✂ All exhibitors must be responsible for their own exhibits. The Association will not assume responsibility for removal, packing and shipping.
- ✂ All articles exhibited will be at the sole risk of the exhibitor.
- ✂ No prizes awarded to any exhibitor for which there is no class.
- ✂ No additional wording can be included on the exhibitor's tag. The exemption to this will be to the school competitors who should include the name of the school under the **Exhibitor's number and name.**
- ✂ **The judge's decision is final.**
- ✂ If a competitor wishes to sell an item, they should speak to the president of the committee, Darleen Sabetta Kerr.
- ✂ **Special Saturday Show** for Saturday, June 13<sup>th</sup>. Registrations will be received up to 9:00 p.m. on Friday, June 12<sup>th</sup>. **Must be brought in before 10:30 a.m. on June 13<sup>th</sup> or will be refused.**
- ✂ All "In Memory" or "Specials" will be for the first-place winners, unless otherwise stated.

**Use recipe below:**

2 cups all purpose flour  
 1 tablespoon baking powder  
 2 teaspoons sugar  
 ½ teaspoons salt  
 ½ cup raisins  
 6 tablespoons cold butter – cut into small pieces  
 ½ cup + 2 tablespoons cream  
 1 egg

**Preheat oven to 400°. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Place dry ingredients in a bowl and whisk together to combine. Add the butter and work in the flour mixture by rubbing together with your hands. Mix just until the largest butter pieces are the size of peas. Add raisin. In a measuring cup, whisk together the cream and egg, then pour this mixture into the flour mixture and combine just until the dough is moistened. Turn out onto work surface and knead a few times to make a smooth, but still slightly rough, dough. Divide dough into 2 parts, and on a lightly floured work surface, roll each one into a 6-inch circle. Brush top of each circle with cream and coat with white sugar. Cut or mark each circle into 5 wedges. Arrange on baking sheet. Place in oven and turn heat down to 375° and bake until deep golden – approximately 20 minutes.**
