## **4-H Judging Competition**

The following classes, (Turkeys, Pumpkins, Corn Cobs, Apple Identification), will be judged by the 4-H members. Classes will be places only, no reasons. Class points will be added to aggregate points total. Judging starts at 1PM.

### **4-H Craft Competition**

**Scarecrows**: Paint a wooden scarecrow for your garden or Halloween (refer to the pictures below). Scarecrows can be between 4'10" and 5' high and 6 inches wide. They must have a pointed end so they can be driven into the ground. They must be brought to the Fairgrounds on Friday evening. They will be judged Friday evening and placed around the fairground for decoration.

Examples of wooden scarecrows:





**Pumpkin carving** – theme – Fall Flavours. Carve a pumpkin with the theme of Fall Flavours.

**Flower Pumpkin arrangements**: expose a Fall floral display including a pumpkin, no wider than 10 inches. No Halloween faces allowed. If wanted, the pumpkin can be empty, in order to receive the flowers.

All entries are to be brought in to the Dining Hall on Friday evening, between 4 and 7 p.m. They will be judged that night and placed around the fairgrounds for display on Saturday and Sunday.

## **4-H Baking Competition**

Junior -7 years old – **Oatmeal cookies** (3 cookies per plate)

Intermediate (7-12 years old) – Pumpkin squares (3 squares per plate)

Senior (13-21 years old) – Apple pie, standard 9-inch pie.

The cookies & squares need to be placed on a sturdy plate (paper or tin plate) and placed into a clear Ziploc bag. We will attach their name, phone number and age on the ticket when they're brought in on Friday night. If need be, toothpicks can be used to keep the top of the bag from sagging onto the top of the squares.

All entries are to be brought in to the Dining Hall on Friday evening, between 4 and 7 p.m. They will be judged that night and placed in the Dining Hall for display on Saturday and Sunday.
