DRAFT HORSE

Entries Close June 7th. No entry fees charged.

No charge for stalls but exhibitors must reserve the number of stalls needed.

Health Regulations: All horses offered for entry to Expo Ormstown must be free from and not have come into contact with any contagious or infectious diseases for a period of at least 60 days prior to the opening of the exhibition. It is recommended that horses have all the necessary vaccinations.

- 1. Registration for exhibitor numbers must be made at the Fair Office.
- 2. Any exhibitor may receive no more than 2 prizes in any one class.
- 3. Two capable drivers are needed on exhibitor's wagons in draft classes including all Junior Classes.
- 4. If showing in Class 9 (6 horse hitch) or in Class 10 (6 horse hitch) you must show in at least 4 classes per day.
- 5. If Expo Ormstown must cancel a class due to weather or unforeseen circumstances and can't reschedule: 60% of purse will be divided equally between entries of the class.
- 6. The Judge and Ringmaster may excuse a competitor from the ring if they are deemed to be out of control, disruptive, or a danger to themselves or others.
- 7. All decisions of the Judge are final. Any complaints must be registered with the committee chairperson immediately following the class. The fee for such a complaint is \$50.00, which will be returned if the protest is sustained.
- 8. All vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas. No vehicles will be allowed to park around the barns without the proper passes and could result in a vehicle being towed.
- 9. Any camper/trailer staying on the grounds with or without hookups must reserve a site.
- 10. There will no longer be leniency at the Exhibitors entrance (Gate #2) After 9:00am, enter using Gate #3, park, and contact the Committee for pick-up.
- 11. All roadways must be kept passable after hitching.
- 12. If you need any supplies of hay, straw, or shavings during the fair, place your order on your entry form.
- 13. No Exhibitors may leave the grounds with their horses before 4 am Sunday morning.
- 14. When on the grounds, drivers and owners are responsible for the control of their horses.
- 15. The committee will keep exhibitors informed of the approximate time of classes. Please be prompt.
- 16. By completing your entry form you acknowledge having read and agree to the rules of the show.
