

1. Every horse needs a current negative Coggins dated no more than 12 months of the opening of the fair
2. All horses offered for entry to Expo Ormstown must be free from, and not have come into contact with any contagious or infectious disease for a period of at least sixty (60) days prior to the opening of the exhibition. It is recommended that animals have all the necessary vaccinations.
3. Owners and Exhibitors Certificate of Insurance (minimum \$1,000,000) must accompany entry forms.
4. Entries must be into the secretary's office by May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022. There will be an additional charge of \$2.00 per entry for those made after the closing date and the entry will not be listed in the horse show program.
5. There will now be 1 entry form for every horse/rider combination.
6. A maximum of \$50.00 in entries will be charged per day per horse.
7. Payment must accompany the entries. No refunds will be given.
8. Taxes are included in the entry fees and stall rentals.
9. On Wednesday and Thursday, the horses may arrive at any time except during Parade time approximately 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm.
10. From Friday to Sunday the horses may arrive and depart from the fairgrounds **prior to 9:00 am.**
11. From Friday to Saturday nights, the horses may depart from the fairgrounds between the hours of 11:00 pm and 9:00 am. Sunday, the horses may leave at the end of the show.
12. LBA, Expo Ormstown, including its directors, committee members and volunteers shall not be responsible in any way for any article or animal lost or stolen on the fairgrounds, nor shall it be responsible for any damage caused by an accident on the fairgrounds.
13. All exhibitors must use stalls – trailers will not necessarily be parked in an area readily accessible to the barns and it is not permitted to tie horses to the trailers in the parking area. Light horse stalls are assigned for the week and are rented at a cost of \$25.00 per stall for the duration of the fair.
14. Stalls will be assigned as best accommodates everyone; no guarantees of specific placement will be given to anyone.
15. Tack stalls are not guaranteed. If there are stalls available after all horses have been accommodated, they will then be distributed in the same order as the requests for tack stalls were received at the office until all requests are fulfilled or no stalls remain. Sharing among exhibitors is encouraged as there will be a limited number.
16. No entry substitutions. When making entries, you must provide the horse's name for each class.
17. All entries in the Halter classes and breed specific classes must be registered and a copy of the registration papers must accompany the entry form.
18. If you wish to scratch from a class, please advise the committee at the sound booth in the hitching ring ASAP.

19. The judge may excuse a competitor from the ring if they are judged to be out of control, disruptive or a danger to themselves or other competitors.
20. All decisions of the judge are final. Any complaints must be registered with the committee chairperson immediately following the class. The fee for such a complaint is \$50.00, which will be refunded if the protest is sustained.
21. ASTM approved helmets are mandatory for all exhibitors under 18 years of age while riding ANYWHERE on the fairgrounds.
22. Ponies are to be 14.2 hands or under. Horses to be 14.2 or over. An animal measuring 14.2 may be shown either as a horse or a pony but must be shown exclusively in one division or the other for the duration of the fair.
23. Numbers are assigned to EXHIBITOR/HORSE COMBINATIONS. It is the responsibility of each rider to be wearing the proper number. In the event that the rider is NOT wearing the proper number they will not be judged.
24. A \$5.00 deposit will be collected for each competitor number. The deposit will be refunded upon the return of the number to the office. Exhibitors may use their own numbers as long as no conflict with other exhibitors exists. Please notify the office if you wish to use your own exhibitor number.
25. Prize money is awarded to the number assigned to the exhibitor/horse combination. Wearing the wrong number may incur errors in prize money distribution. These errors are not the responsibility of the office and will not be corrected by the office.
26. We will gladly accept the return of ribbons from past or present that do not have dated on them and are in good condition.
- 27. All trailers and campers staying on the grounds, with or without hook up must be reserved at the time of registration. This includes stock trailers or other vehicles used for sleeping.**
