

Please note, due to the continued spread of the Avian Flu, there will not be a 2023 poultry exhibition.

1. All entries must be in the office of the Secretary on or before May 31st, 2023. The right is reserved to accept or refuse any entry.
2. Entries must be made using www.assistexpo.ca or on the regular form, which will be found with the prize list or will be provided by the Secretary on application. Specific breed and variety for each entry must be stated on the form.
3. Birds and animals entered should be in place by 4:00 p.m., Thursday, June 8th, and may not be removed until after 3:00 p.m., Sunday, June 11th. Exhibitors who remove birds or animals before the deadline without permission will forfeit ALL prize awards. Special accommodations might be permitted for exhibitors travelling from out of province.
4. **Entry fees are \$2.00 per entry (taxes included). Entry fees will not be refunded. Entries received after May 31st will be charged double.**
5. **There will also be a maximum entry fee of \$50.00 to help promote more entries. Unlimited free registration after the first 25 entries unless registration is received after May 31st.**
6. Poultry will be judged according to the American Standard of Perfection.
7. Poultry coops provided free; feed and water also furnished free.
8. No exhibits will be admitted unless entry has been made. Official entry tickets must not be removed from cages.
9. Where two or more of the same variety or sex are being shown, leg bands should be used to avoid mistake.
10. Judging will start at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 10th.
11. All specimens must be bona fide property of exhibitor.
12. The judge maintains the privilege of withholding a prize in any class where he feels that there is no specimen sufficiently qualified to receive it.
13. All exhibits entered at owner's own risk.
14. No owner identification of any kind to be placed on exhibits until judging is finished.
