

FALL FESTIVAL CATTLE RULES

VACCINE PASSEPORT WILL BE MANDATORY UPON ARRIVAL ON THE FAIRGROUNDS FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS.

Entries close September 29th, 2021

4-H showmanship classes will begin at 3:00 p.m., Saturday October 2nd. The conformation classes and open show will follow at 4:30 p.m.

1. Animals must be registered at office before entering grounds.
2. **No hat bands will be given without payment of entry fees.**
3. Entry fees are not refundable. GST and PST are included.
 - a. Fees for early-bird entries (any entries before September 24th): \$10/head
 - b. Fees for late entries (any entries after September 25th): \$20/head
4. Cattle classes will be shown as scheduled and exhibitors are requested to have their cattle on the grounds by 9:00 a.m. on Saturday Oct 2nd. Chateauguay Valley Exhibitors and animals may leave the Expo grounds on Sunday, October 3rd at 3:00 p.m. Exterior visitors may leave the grounds between midnight and 9:00 a.m. Sunday, October 3rd. Exhibitors are asked to let us know by September 29th, if they are unable to attend.
5. **Stalls will be allotted as to the date of the entry payment to the secretary. Anything placed in the barns before stalls are allotted will be removed.**
6. No vehicles are allowed to park in front of barns.
7. The number of animals presented by an exhibitor is unlimited. The points of the 10 best animals will be kept for the calculation of the junior and senior banners, in respective breed shows. In addition, there is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor can present within each class.
8. Exhibitors will be permitted to substitute animals as long as they do not exceed the number of entries allowed to be exhibited.
9. The cattle committee recommends classes 1,2 and 3 be shown by 4-H members.
10. Only animals of 75% Registered Ancestry or higher are eligible to participate in the show. All animals must be registered at the time of making entries. The registered name, the ATQ number of the animal, the ATQ site number, name and registration numbers of the sire and dam, and all other pertinent information must be included and clearly printed on the entry form. All animals must be tagged or they will not be permitted on the grounds. If an animal is found without their tags, the exhibitor will be held liable for any infractions.
11. Verification of animals will take place Friday at 10:00 a.m. All exhibitors are asked to have someone present with their animals with registration certificates and production certificates during this time.
12. There must be a least three exhibitors and 24 entries shown in each breed for dairy conformation classes to be recognized by their respective associations. If less than three exhibitors and less than 24 head in one of the following breeds: Holstein, Ayrshire and Jersey, only 50% of the prizes offered will be paid.
13. No animal may be shown in more than one class for single animals except for a championship or a special prize class. To be eligible for a group class, every member of the group must be exhibited in its appropriate class for a single animal.
14. **HEALTH REGULATIONS:** All cattle entered for the show must be free from and not have come in contact with any contagious or infectious diseases for a period of at least sixty days prior to the opening of the exhibition. It is recommended that animals have all the necessary vaccinations.
15. Exhibitors with dairy cows have access to the milking parlour. Exhibitors are required to bring a wheelbarrow for removing manure to the manure pile.

16. All “showmen” are to be dressed in white pants before entering the ring.
17. Reserved camper-trailer hook-ups are available at a cost of \$75/hookup for the duration of the festival. Please indicate on your entry form if you require a hookup and the length of your trailer.
18. Exhibitors must adhere to the Rules and Regulations relating to the presentation of dairy cattle.

Best udder

The judge shall designate the best udder in each of the classes 9-17. Ribbons only.

Best Bred and Owned

Animals whose prefix belongs to the owner (or one of the owners). The exhibitor must solely or jointly own the animal.

The Judge shall designate the best-bred owned animal in each in classes 1-7 and 9-17. Ribbons only.

Intermediate Champions

Intermediate Championship will be applied for classes 9-14. Ribbons only.

Grand Champions

Applied to Grand and Reserve Intermediate Champions and classes 15-17. Ribbons only.

Premier Breeder & Exhibitor

Premier Breeder Presented to the breeding unit (individual, partnership, or institution) having the highest number of points won in individual female classes with a maximum of 10 animals considered for award calculation. Animals used for the award calculation do not necessarily have to be owned by the winner. Calculation of the Premier Breeder award is determined strictly by the prefix of the animal, which can be identified on the Certificate of Registry. Premier Exhibitor Presented to the exhibitor/owner (individual, partnership, or institution) having the highest number of points won in individual female classes by not more than 10 animals owned by the exhibitor. This does not limit the number of animals that may be shown. In the case of jointly-owned animals, joint ownership is considered as one exhibitor. No part of the points awarded counts toward the individual score of any of the joint owners.

- The 4-H Competition is open to registered 4-H members in good standing aged 6 - 21 inclusively (as of January 1st, 2021).** Children aged 8 and under who are not registered with 4-H for the 2021 year but who would like to participate, may be entered in the Clover bud showmanship class, for non-members.

*Peewee Contestants (aged 6-8 on January 1st) may participate in the Peewee Showmanship class and in the 4-H conformation classes as long as they:

- are a paid registered member of 4-H
- have a calf to show which is not already being shown in 4-H
- register the calf in the appropriate conformation class
- show the calf independently
